About CoToAYR

CoToAYR is a two-year European project, co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission. The project aims to foster youth cooperation and youth exchange programs on the prevention of violence, radicalization, xenophobia and racism.

Start: 15-12-2018 - End: 16-08-2020

The project is aimed directly at youth workers realizes a functional educational and pedagogical tool for the promotion of European values: respect for human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, tolerance the rule of law and respect for human rights, including the rights of persons belonging to minorities. The project intends to create tool for useful to youth work, develop and convey messages aimed at deconstructing extremist propaganda in frontline work with young people (new migrants, immigrants and young natives) and fostering integration through inter-religious dialogue and intercultural knowledge based on the knowledge of the other. The project contributes to promoting the development of social and civic and intercultural competences and critical thinking in young people and also to face radicalization, discrimination, racism and violence. helps to fill these gaps through the dissemination of knowledge and the construction of these tools will take place through the collection of experiences, needs and proposals of young workers working in different countries (Finland, Sweden, Italy, Spain, Kenya and Somalia) and in various areas that concern the world of young people (schools, cultural associations, NGOs, youth centers, reception centers for young migrants, etc).



Objectives

- Improve the quality of youth work
- Offer youth workers an informal and customizable learning tool to help them in their role as providers of non-formal learning opportunities to be exploited subsequently with different targets in different context.
- Give youth workers an easy tool to be exploited in their daily work
- Empower youth workers, young, and new migrants and refugees
- Develop and facilitate the training of frontline operators working with groups of young people to refine their understanding of the radicalization process
- Offer them flexible, updated, easy tools to be used in the educational practice of preventing radicalization.
- Increase the knowledge, sharing and respect of European values on: human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law and respect for human rights, including the rights of persons belonging to minorities



Activities

1. Kick off Meeting in Sweden

The 1st international meeting will be organized by the project coordinator **Eu Diaspora Council** during the 1st month of the project activities. During the meeting, the following points will be scheduled in the agenda:-

- Identified tools will be prepared and shared within the partnership order to have a common tool that incorporates goals, strategies and methods a folder drive will be set up.
- The punctual planning of the activities of Interviews face to face and questionnaires on line, structuring the form of interview and questionnaire meeting.
- Definition of the first steps for the implementation of the “Brochure youth worker against radicalization”
- A focus on migration, integration and analysis of Swedish English and Finnish radicalization prevention systems.
- The definition of the dissemination plan describing in details the actions each partner will carry out to assure project dissemination and exploitation -and any other request/task
